VAN ATTA'S, in conjunction with the **REGIONAL RECYCLING COORDINATING COMMITTEE**, is pleased to announce a pilot program to assist residents in recycling a variety of containers used in planting. See the information below about the types of containers accepted and how they should be prepared.

ACCEPTED ITEMS & GUIDELINES

Most types of containers will be accepted, but items are generally limited to pots, flats, plug trays and cell packs with one of these symbols on the bottom of the container.



HDPE – High Density Polyethylene



PP – Polypropylene



PS – Polystyrene

All items must be free of dirt, with like items stacked together. Any items with dirt or debris, or not stacked neatly, will be turned away. Please understand the labor necessary to package items for transport to a recycler and respect these requirements.
